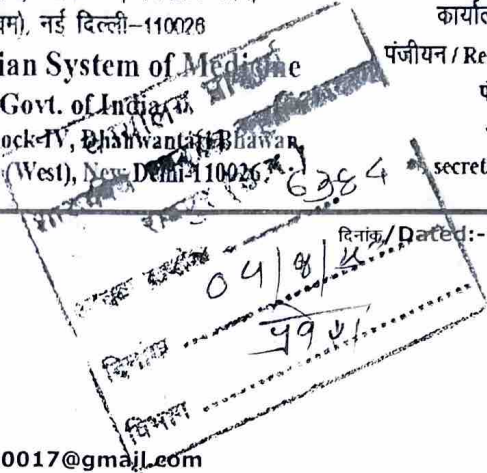

Subject:- Grant of Yearly Permission with seat reduction to Shri Narayan Prasad Awasthi Government Ayurved College, Raipur, Chhattisgarh (Inst. ID-AYU0017) for intake capacity with 57 seats (71 seats including EWS) [instead of 60 seats (75 seats including EWS)] in UG (BAMS) course, and Extended Permission of 10 PG courses with intake capacity of 47 seats (59 seats including EWS) namely (i) Ayurved Samhita, Sanskrit & Siddhanta-03 seats (04 seats including EWS) (ii) Agad Tantra avum Vidhi Vaidyaka-06 seats (07 seats including EWS) (iii) Dravyaguna Vigyana-06 seats (08 seats including EWS) (iv) Kriya Sharir-06 seats (08 seats including EWS) (v) Kayachikitsa-05 seats (06 seats including EWS) (vi) Shalya-03 seats (04 seats including EWS) (vii) Rachna Sharir-03 seats (04 seats including EWS) (viii) Rasa Shastra & Bhaisajya Kalpana-03 seats (04 seats including EWS) (ix) Rog Nidan-Rog Nidanavum Vikriti Vigyan-06 seats (07 seats including EWS) (x) Kaumarbhritya-Bala Roga-06 seats (07 seats including EWS) and Yearly Permission in Swasthavritta-05 seats (06 seats including EWS)[instead of 06 seats (07 seats including EWS)] under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2025-26 -reg.

Sir/Madam,

- 1) To assess the available facilities of teaching, non-teaching, hospital staff, practical training and other infrastructure facilities at your college namely Shri Narayan Prasad Awasthi Government Ayurved College, Raipur, Chhattisgarh (Inst. ID-AYU0017) inspection was conducted on 11.03.2025 and 12.03.2025 in hybrid mode as a part of annual visitation by the visitation team of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine NCISM to process the permission for intake capacity with 60 seats (75 seats including EWS) in UG (BAMS) course, and 53 seats (66 seats including EWS) in 11 PG courses namely (i) Ayurved Samhita, Sanskrit & Siddhanta-03 seats (04 seats including EWS) (ii) Agad Tantra avum Vidhi Vaidyaka-06 seats (07 seats including EWS) (iii) Dravyaguna Vigyana-06 seats (08 seats including EWS) (iv) Kriya Sharir-06 seats (08 seats including EWS) (v) Kayachikitsa-05 seats (06 seats including EWS) (vi) Shalya-03 seats (04 seats including EWS) (vii) Swasthavritta-06 seats (07 seats including EWS) (viii) Rachna Sharir-03 seats (04 seats including EWS) (ix) Rasa Shastra & Bhaisajya Kalpana-03 seats (04 seats including EWS) (x) Rog Nidan-Rog Nidanavum Vikriti Vigyan-06 seats (07 seats including EWS) (xi) Kaumarbhritya-Bala Roga-06 seats (07 seats including EWS) under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2025-26.
- 2) The visitation report and all other related documents were assessed in terms of enforced regulations namely the Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Undergraduate Ayurveda colleges and Attached Teaching Hospitals Regulations, 2024", Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Postgraduate Institutions and Minimum Standards for Postgraduate Education in Ayurveda Regulations 2024", NCISM (Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Postgraduate Institutions and Minimum Standards for Postgraduate Education in Ayurveda) Regulations, 2024 and provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder. **On careful examination of the assessment report and as per the Visitors Observation following shortcomings/defects have been observed:-**

1. Teaching staffs:-

Availability of total teaching staff for UG(BAMS) Course as per the part-1 submitted by the college is $\frac{\text{Available}}{\text{Required}} \times 100\% = \frac{29}{30} \times 100\% = 96.66\%$ (Excluding Excess)

2. Non-teaching staff: -

Availability of Non-Teaching staff is $\frac{\text{Available}}{\text{Required}} \times 100\% = \frac{42}{43} \times 100\% = 97.67\%$.

3. Other infrastructure details:-

(a) Animal house is **not available. MoU not attached.**

4. Mean of general and essential equipment's/instruments availability is **72.10%**.

3) Further, the assessment report was duly placed before the **129th Board meeting** of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) held on **27.06.2025** and Board observed that the college is **not fulfilling the notified & requisite criteria for issuance of permission in UG (BAMS) Course** due to deficiency in of teaching staff and hospital staff and **not fulfilling in 01 PG courses** due to deficiency in required number of teaching staff for PG courses but is fulfilling for Extended Permission in **10 PG courses** with intake capacity of 47 seats (59 seats including EWS) under section 28 of NCISM Act 2020 for the Academic Session 2025-26. However, the Board decided as follows:-

- To issue Yearly Permission in UG (BAMS) Course due to deficiency in hospital staff and instruments in accordance with Regulation 55(a) of Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Undergraduate Ayurveda colleges 2024 as per the approved seat reduction policy under section 28(1)(f) of NCISM Act, 2020.
- To issue Extended Permission in 10 PG Courses that the college fulfilling the notified & requisite criteria of extended permission in accordance with Regulation 15(5) of NCISM (Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Postgraduate Institutions and Minimum Standards for Postgraduate Education in Ayurveda) Regulation, 2024.
- To issue Yearly Permission in 01 PG Course Swasthavritta as per the teacher-student ratio in accordance with Regulation 15(7) of NCISM (Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Postgraduate Institutions and Minimum Standards for Postgraduate Education in Ayurveda) Regulation, 2024 as per the available teacher-student ratio, under section 28(1)(f) of NCISM Act, 2020.

As per the seat reduction policy 2025-26 approved in 122nd Board meeting of MARB-ISM:-

i) For UG course :-

a) For non-availability of every 01 DMS Seat reduction in the intake capacity shall be considered by reducing the intake strength by 01 seat. As there is shortcoming of 01 DMS against the minimum requirement of 01, therefore seat reduction in the intake capacity shall be considered by reducing the intake strength by 01 seat.

b) For Instruments:-

For every 10% deficiency in instruments, seat reduction in the intake capacity shall be considered by reducing the intake strength by 01 seat.

Availability of Mean of general and essential equipment's/instruments is **72.10% (round off to 80%)** against the minimum requirement of 100 % and there is **deficiency of 20%**. Therefore, in accordance of seat reduction policy 2025-26 seat reduction in the intake capacity shall be considered by reducing the intake strength by 02 seats.

ii) For PG Course:-

As per sub-Regulation 2 of Regulation 19 of Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Undergraduate Ayurveda colleges 2024, The Teacher student ratio shall be subject to availability of student-Postgraduate guide in the ratio of 3:1, for three students for one Professor; in case of

Associate Professor 2:1 two students for one Associate Professor; and in case of Assistant Professor the ration is 1:1 one student for one Assistant Professor.

a) In the Department of Swasthavritta -The college is having 04 eligible teaching faculties, 02 Assistant Professor, 01 Associate Professor and 01 professor for PG. However, the available 02 Assistant Professors are not having more than 05 years of teaching experience. **Hence, As per the available faculty the college is not fulfilling the teacher student ratio as per the submitted seats in Part-1 but is eligible for issuance of permission for only 05 seats instead of 06 seats.**

4) Hence, after applying the seat reduction policy 2025-26 under section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act 2020, the college is fulfilling the basic eligibility criteria for issuance of Yearly Permission with **57 seats (71 seats including EWS) [instead of 60 seats (75 seats including EWS)]** in UG (BAMS) course as per regulation 55(a) of Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Undergraduate Ayurveda colleges 2024 and Yearly permission in **01 PG course with intake capacity of 05 seats (06 seats including EWS) [instead of 06 seats (07 seats including EWS)]** as per Regulation 15(7) of NCISM (Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Postgraduate Institutions and Minimum Standards for Postgraduate Education in Ayurveda) Regulations 2024 and Extended Permission.

5) Further, in accordance with Regulation 55(9) of Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Undergraduate Ayurveda colleges 2024 eligibility of Extended Permission for the academic session 2025-26 of **Shri Narayan Prasad Awasthi Government Ayurved College, Raipur, Chhattisgarh (Inst. ID-AYU0017)** in UG (BAMS) course is hereby withdrawn

"DECISION"

6) Therefore, in view of the above **Shri Narayan Prasad Awasthi Government Ayurved College, Raipur, Chhattisgarh (Inst. ID-AYU0017)** is hereby granted as follows :

a) **Yearly Permission with intake capacity of intake capacity of 57 seats (71 seats including EWS) [instead of 60 seats (75 seats including EWS)]** in UG BAMS course in accordance with regulation 55(9) of NCISM (Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Postgraduate Institutions and Minimum Standards for undergraduate Education in Ayurveda) Regulations, 2024, under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2025-26.

b) **Extended Permission with 10 PG courses with intake capacity of 47 seats (59 seats including EWS) namely (i) Ayurved Samhita, Sanskrit & Siddhanta-03 seats (04 seats including EWS) (ii) Agad Tantra avum Vidhi Vaidyaka-06 seats (07 seats including EWS) (iii) Dravyaguna Vigyana-06 seats (08 seats including EWS) (iv) Kriya Sharir-06 seats (08 seats including EWS) (v) Kayachikitsa-05 seats (06 seats including EWS) (vi) Shalya-03 seats (04 seats including EWS) (vii) Rachna Sharir-03 seats (04 seats including EWS) (viii) Rasa Shastra & Bhaisajya Kalpana-03 seats (04 seats including EWS) (ix) Rog Nidan-Rog Nidanavum Vikriti Vigyan-06 seats (07 seats including EWS) (x) Kaumarbhritya-Bala Roga-06 seats (07 seats including EWS)** in accordance with regulation 15(5) of NCISM (Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Postgraduate Institutions and Minimum Standards for Postgraduate Education in Ayurveda) Regulations, 2024.

c) **Yearly Permission in 01 PG Course Swasthavritta-05 seats (06 seats including EWS)[instead of 06 seats (07 seats including EWS)]** due to seat reduction in accordance with regulation 15(7) of NCISM (Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Postgraduate Institutions and Minimum Standards for Postgraduate Education in Ayurveda) Regulations, 2024 under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2025-26 .

7) **The aforementioned decision is issued under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 subject to the condition that following requirements shall be fulfilled:-**

I. It is further informed that minimum **15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted with intake capacity of 57 seats (71 seats including EWS) [instead of 60 seats (75 seats including EWS)] and 52 Seats (65 Seats including EWS) [instead of 53 seats (66 seats including EWS)]** in **11 PG courses** shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling authority as designated by Central Government for A.Y. 2025-26 and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State/UT. **The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government/NCISM for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.**

8) Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & Regulations thereunder.

9) **Further, as per Sub-section (7) of Section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020,** The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine may conduct evaluation and assessment of any University or medical institution at any time, either directly or through any other expert, having integrity and experience in medical profession, without any prior notice and assess and evaluate the performance, standards and benchmarks of such University or medical institution and if the college is found to be not maintaining the Minimum Essential standards as specified in the concerned acts & regulations then **in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act, 2020 the issued permission of the college shall deemed to be withdrawn and denial of permission shall be issued by MARBISM for stoppage of admission for that particular academic year or the subsequent year.**

- 10) Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.
- 11) Compliance of all the requirements of Aadhaar Enabled Biometric Attendance System as mentioned in the Implementation letters vide. ref. no. 3/2024/MARB/AEBAS & HMS. Dated 09.05.2024 & 06.09.2024 issued by the Board.
- 12) **The following requirements must be fulfilled and the compliance report must reach the Board by 31st December, 2025 to be considered for the issuance of Renewal of permission for the academic session 2026-2027:-**
 - i) All the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled.
 - ii) All the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in NCISM (Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for undergraduate Ayurveda colleges and attached teaching hospitals) Regulations, 2024.
 - iii) All the requirements of Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Postgraduate Institutions and Minimum Standards for Postgraduate Education in Ayurveda, Regulations, 2024,
 - iv) All the requirements of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations-2022.
 - v) The remaining shortcoming mentioned in Para no. 2, shall be fulfilled.
- 13) In case if you are not satisfied with the decision of Medical Assessment and Rating Board, NCISM, you may prefer an appeal addressed to the Chairman NCISM, within 15 days of issuance of the letter as per Regulation 65 of MESAR 2024 and Regulation 29(5) of NCISM Act 2020.
- 14) The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college within the timeline as mentioned above to the President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the permission for the academic session 2026-27.
